- Mallet 3:** Plays a steady melodic line of quarter notes throughout.
- Percussion:** Plays a steady melodic line of quarter notes throughout, starting with a mezzo-forte (*mf*) dynamic. A note in measure 2 is marked "Begin Voice Quote".
