The score is for a 15-measure piece in 4/4 time, marked Moderato (MM-88). The key signature has three flats (B-flat, E-flat, A-flat). The rest of the ensemble is mostly silent until measure 15, where they all play a final chord. Dynamics include *f* (forte) and *mf* (mezzo-forte). The percussion part is indicated by a double bar line with a vertical line through it.

Guard dancing slowly with serving trays, very heroic and dignified. Others join first soloist over time.

Note: LB Soloists should be top 3 players, just put on these parts for convenience.
